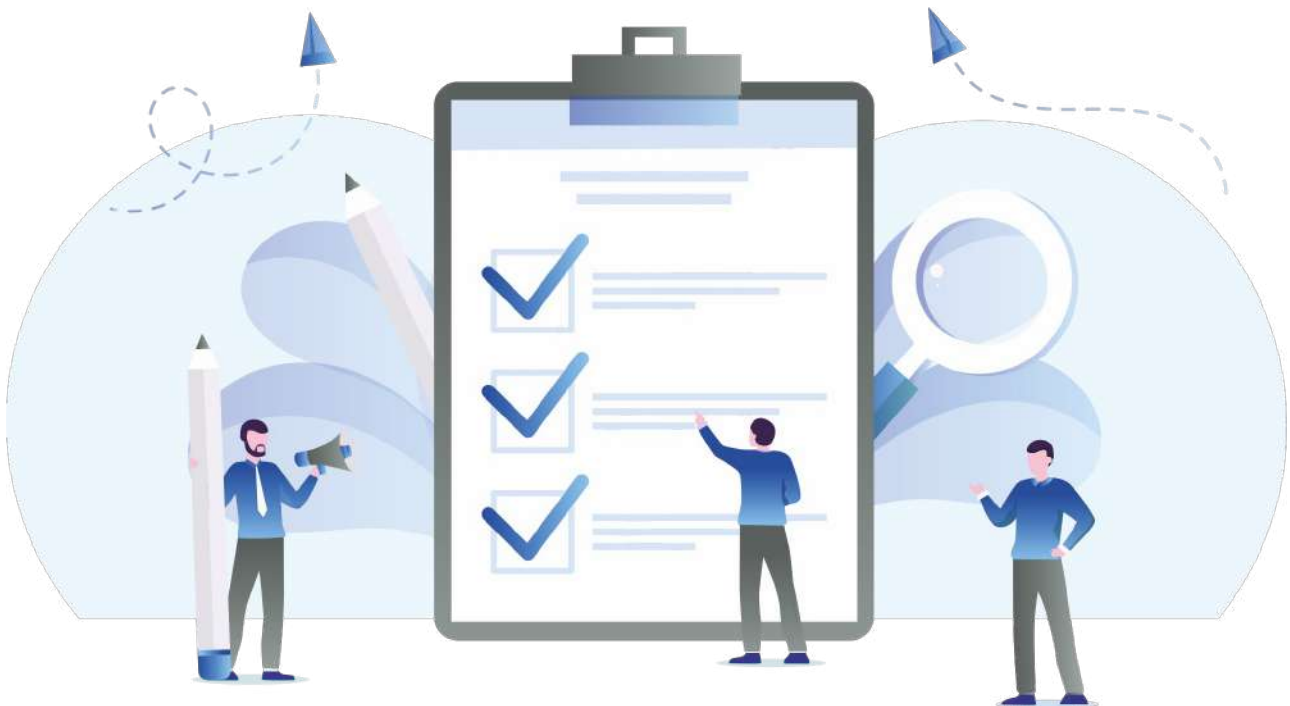

> **Academic Transcripts (Degree, Diploma or Certificate)**

 Required  Original



Certified copy of an official transcript of your primary dentistry education course completed in original language

> **Educational Certificate (Degree, Diploma or Certificate)**  Required  Original



Certified copy of Degree, Diploma or Certificate in English Translation

> **Curriculum Vitae or Resume**  Required  Original

> **Australian Federal Police Check**  Recommend  Original

Provide an Australian police certificate (AFP) if you have spent a total of 12 months or more in Australia in the last 10 years since you turned 16. Standard disclosure certificates or national police certificates issued by Australian state or territory police will not be Acceptable. For immigration purposes, Australian police certificates are valid for 12 months from the date of issue.

> **Parental Consent Form [Form 1229]**

 Recommend  Original

If you have a child under the age of 18 included in the visa application and one or both parents (or legal guardians) are not applying for an Australian visa, both parents will need to complete and sign the Form 1229 - Consent form to grant an Australian visa to a child under the age of 18 years. If you have sole custody of the child/ren, provide evidence such as a court order.

> **Details of a child or other dependent family member aged 18 years or over [Form 47a]**
