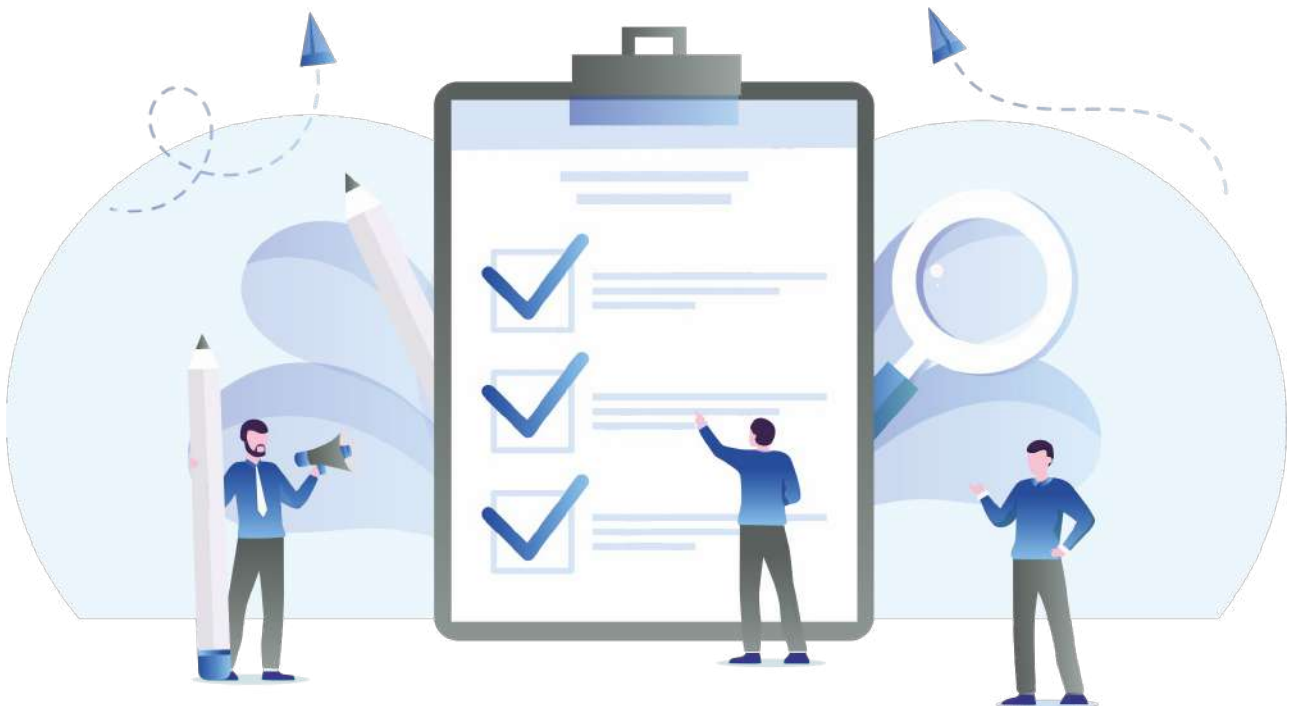

Other Documents

> Passport

 Required  Original

Current passport all Pages are required

> Birth Certificate or Adoption Letter (if applicable)

 Required  Original

For every dependant 18 years old or younger who are applying with you, provide: - Copies of birth certificates or the family book showing the names of both parents of all your dependent children - copies of the adoption paper, if applicable.

> Evidence of English Ability

 Required  Original

Acceptable English Test are: 1) IELTS Academic 2) PTE Academic 3) TOEFL iBT 4) Cambridge English: Advanced 5) Occupational English Test (OET) English Test is valid for 3 years

Health Insurance

> Health Insurance

 Required  Original

You will need to provide evidence of adequate health insurance for you and your family members for the duration of your stay in Australia.

Applicant's Personal Details

> National Identity Document

 Recommend  Original

copy of National Identity Card (both sides) if you have one

> Change of Name documents

 Recommend  Original

Submit the documents that provides evidence of name change. Documents may serve as an evidence include: • a marriage or divorce certificate • change of name documents from an Australian Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages, or the relevant overseas authority • documents that show other names you have been known by

Evidence of Employment

> Sponsorship documents

 Required  Original

You need to provide: a sponsor approval letter or receipt for submission of the sponsorship application your sponsor's nomination approval letter or receipt for submission of the nomination application – if your sponsor is not an Australian Commonwealth Government agency a written statement from the sponsor that they will meet the sponsorship obligations for you and all dependent family members included in your application.

◎ Character Documents

> Overseas Police Clearance Certificate

 Recommend  Original

You may be required to provide a police certificate (also called a penal clearance certificate) from every country you lived in. It will usually be if you are over 17 and lived in any of the listed countries, including Australia, for at least 12 months in the past 10 years. Police certificates are valid for 12 months from the issue date. They must cover: • the time you turned 16 up to the issue date OR • the whole time you were in the country

> Australian Federal Police Check

 Required  Original

Provide a copy of your Australian Federal Police check. This is generally required when you have spent a total of 12 months in Australia after turning 16 years of age.

> Military Certificate

 Recommend  Original

You may need to provide a military certificate with your visa application. If required, it will usually be when you served for more than 12 months in any country's military force. A military certificate can be a letter from your commanding officer. It should say you have not been convicted of any criminal offence while in the military. You may also need to provide a police certificate for every country you served in for over 12 months. This includes where you were stationed at a military base.

> Financial Documents

 Required  Original

Financial Support Documents You will need to show evidence of your financial capacity to support yourself and your family while you are in Australia, such as: • bank statements • a letter from your financial institution stating your financial position • employment contracts • documents showing allowances, accommodation and stipends from your sponsor while you are in Australia • if you are currently or were previously an AusAID or Foreign Affairs supported student provide a copy of the letter of support from the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

◎ English Language Ability Test

> English Proficiency

 Required  Original

Provide evidence that you have functional English language skills to undertake the training programme. You do not need to provide these results if you hold a valid passport from: • the United Kingdom • Canada • New Zealand • the United States • the Republic of Ireland

Partner Documents

> Proof of Relationship

 Required  Original

Please provide a proof of your relationship. You must provide evidence that the relationship is genuine and continuing. Evidence may include: • joint bank account statements • billing accounts in joint names • joint leases or mortgages • documents that show your partner has lived at the same address as you For de facto relationships provide either: • evidence that your relationship is registered by an Australian State or Territory • enough documents to prove you have been in a de facto relationship with your partner for at least 12 months before you apply

Provide a copy of your Australian Federal Police check. This is generally required when you have spent a total of 12 months in Australia after turning 16 years of age.

Dependents under 18 years of age

> Birth Certificate or Adoption Letter (if applicable)

 Required  Original

Provide a copy of your birth certificate showing the names of both parents. Alternatively, you can also provide copies of the family book showing the names of both parents of all your dependent children. You can also provide adoption papers, if applicable.

> Parental responsibility documents

 Required  Original

All the applicants under 18 years of age must have a consent to migration to Australia from anyone who has a legal right to decide where the child lives AND is not coming to Australia with the child. Consent can be given by: • Form 1229 Consent form to grant an Australian visa to a child under the age of 18 years (168KB PDF) OR • a statutory declaration giving their consent for the child to visit Australia on this visa Alternatively, you can provide an Australian court order that allows your child to migrate to Australia, OR that the laws of your home country allow them to migrate Include an identity document that shows the signature and photo of the person who completed the form or declaration, such as a passport or driver's licence AND adoption papers or other court documents if applicable.

⊙ Dependents above 18 years of age

> Proof of financial dependency

 Required  Original

Provide evidence that all the dependents aged 18 years or older are financial dependent on you. Evidence may include bank statements, money transfers and rent receipts. If the child is aged 23 or is likely to turn 23 while your application is being processed, you must also provide a report from a qualified medical practitioner that states they are dependent on you or your partner due to the total or partial loss of their bodily or mental functions
